This grant writing session is for a non-government audience and introduces participants to the basic components of writing a successful grant under the Documentary Heritage Program of the New York State Archives. The session would be of interest to those working in a not-for-profit archives, civic association, historical society, library, museum, and similar institution within the State of New York. Projects to be carried out by service providers such as historical service agencies, colleges, universities, professional associations, or other non-profit institutions, and religious institutions (under certain circumstances) may be eligible.

If your organization is planning to submit a grant to the New York State Archives-Documentary Heritage Program, attendance at this workshop is most essential.

Deadline for submitting a grant under the Documentary Heritage Program is **February 1, 2009**.
