OHEKA CASTLE Hotel & Estate is located in Huntington, New York on the Historic Otto H. Kahn Estate, just 32 miles from midtown Manhattan with an estimated driving time of 45 minutes.

GPS Address: 135 Gate Drive (West) - Huntington - New York

From Manhattan and Nassau County

1. Take the Queens Midtown Tunnel to the Long Island Expressway (I-495) East.
2. Take the Long Island Expressway (I-495) East to Exit 48 (Round Swamp Road).
3. Turn left onto Round Swamp Road (North) to Jericho Tpke (Rt. 25) & turn left (West).
4. At the 1st Traffic Light, make a sharp right turn into the stone-walled entrance onto West Gate Drive.

Follow West Gate Drive, bearing left and continue to the Front Gate Entrance at OHEKA

From Eastern Long Island

1. Take the Long Island Expressway (I-495) West to exit 48 (Round Swamp Road).
2. Turn right onto Round Swamp Road (North) to Jericho Tpke (Rt. 25) & turn left (West).
3. At the 1st Traffic Light, make a sharp right turn into the stone-walled entrance onto West Gate Drive.
4. Follow West Gate Drive, bearing left and continue to the Front Gate Entrance at OHEKA.
